Horizon School of Radiography Moncton	<p>The Horizon School of Radiography Moncton Campus is partnered with UNBSJ to deliver a 4-year BHS in Radiography. Students in the program complete 2 years at UNBSJ then 2 years at The Horizon School of Radiography Moncton Campus. Graduates of the program become a radiological (x-ray) technologist.</p> <p>Applicants begin by entering the Bachelor of Health Sciences at UNBSJ. To apply: http://www.unb.ca/admissions/applying-to-unb/index.html</p> <p>During Year 1 students apply to the Horizon School of Radiography; this is a competitive major and involves an interview process. Students accepted into the Horizon School of Radiography Moncton Campus complete 3 additional years of education and training. Year 2 students complete university courses at UNBSJ in health sciences such as Health Care Ethics. Year 3 and 4 entail theory and clinical education specific to radiography at The Moncton Hospital.</p> <p>The work of a Radiologic Technologist covers a broad variety of procedures such as: x-rays of the chest, spine, bones, and joints; gastrointestinal studies; fluoroscopy (real-time imaging), mammography, CT scans, and Interventional Radiology.</p>
