Our breakout session will start with the formal presentation and end as more of a conversation with the attendees, seeking to understand their interests and demonstrate how they may align with our program.

Horizon School of Radiography of Moncton (HEALTH)

The Horizon School of Radiography Moncton Campus is partnered with UNBSJ to deliver a 4-year BHS in Radiography. Students in the program complete 2 years at UNBSJ then 2 years at The Horizon School of Radiography Moncton Campus.

Applicants begin by entering the Bachelor of Health Sciences at UNBSJ. To apply:

- Year 1 students apply to the Horizon School of Radiography; this is a competitive major and involves an interview process. Students accepted into the Horizon School of Radiography Moncton Campus complete 3 additional years of education and training.
- Year 2 students complete university courses at UNBSJ in health sciences such as Health Care Ethics.
- Year 3 and 4 entail theory and clinical education specific to radiography at The Moncton Hospital.

Graduates of the program become a radiological (x-ray) technologist. A Radiological Technologist covers a broad variety of procedures such as: x-rays of the chest, spine, bones, and joints; gastrointestinal studies; fluoroscopy (real-time imaging), mammography, CT scans, and Interventional Radiology.

IDEA Centre (HIGH SCHOOL PATHWAY)

We will host a session outlining the IDEA Centre, available to current Grade 10 or 11 students. We will cover alumni projects, brainstorm how our team can support students, and do some brainstorming and ideation activities for interested students.
